Recommendation of Newton Simpson

Mr Newton Simpson is a private investigator. He served as a police officer with great distinction, being wounded on at least three occasions in the line of duty. He is a brilliant reconnaissance agent being able to blend into most situations.

Newton Simpson is a 9mm specialist. He is a crack shot with this weapon. He is frequently relied on by executives, lawyers and investors for protection when traveling to the Caribbean. Mr Simpson was qualified in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit in Miami Dade County as a ballistics expert in the State of Florida vs Kendal Major. He testified with academic brilliance in this case and his testimony concerning bullet casings of 9mm and shotgun spent shells was accepted by the Judge as being credible and helpful.

Mr Simpson assisted professionally in the State of Florida v Lance Armstrong. He assisted in preparing the logistics of arranging depositions for the Sentencing Hearing. State of Florida v Lance Armstrong is a first degree murder case with a death penalty request. During this case Mr Simpson worked closely with Florida State Attorneys and their Investigative staff from the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit in Broward County.

Mr Simpson has regularly assisted me in obtaining materials for my Caribbean Law program at the University of Miami, and he keeps me advised of extradition developments in Jamaica, as I am a member of the Jamaica Bar and I specialize in that area of practice.
